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What is a social welfare center?

Social Welfare Center Definition

It refers to a facility that is equipped with certain facilities and professional personnel based on the community and provides comprehensive welfare services to prevent and solve community welfare problems through the participation and cooperation of local residents.
 Here, community welfare refers to social welfare developed at the community level to promote the welfare of residents and improve their quality of life.

Social Welfare Center Goals

 Social welfare centers provide the welfare services they need, such as protection services, home welfare services, and education and training to develop self-reliance skills, to all community residents who have a need for social welfare services, and strengthen family functions and create a sense of solidarity among residents. As a comprehensive welfare service delivery organization that prevents and treats various community problems, it must play a central role in promoting the welfare of community residents.



- We provide daily living care to seniors over 65 years old who have difficulty returning to their daily lives after being discharged from a medical institution, helping them safely return to their residence.

Target

Seniors aged 65 or older who live in Buk-gu and need daily care after being discharged from a medical institution (People receiving basic livelihood security, people over 65 years old, people with disabilities, etc.)

Number of users : 10,296people/year

 Purpose of leisure activities for local residents through various functional education programs and cultural events


